Protection of Civilians

- Enhance capacity of local authorities
- Secure environment
- Fight against impunity and greater accountability

DDR

• Balanced, realistically financed program based on transparent and verifiable database

SSR

 Develop and implement national SSR Action Plan with realistic budget

Political Dialogue and Reconciliation

- Land reform
- Responsible coverage by Ivorian media
- Dialogue and reconciliation activities at the local level

Rule of Law and State Authority

- Local authorities deployed and fully operational
- Independent, equitable and efficient justice system
- Strengthened penitentiary services

Rationale: Planning, monitoring and reporting

• Mission centralized planning, monitoring and reporting tool

• Need to <u>prioritize</u> (given context, budget restrictions etc)

• Focus on concrete <u>results</u> and progress

• Ensure <u>follow up</u> and correcti<u>ve action</u> if necessary

• Guides work plans and e-performance


